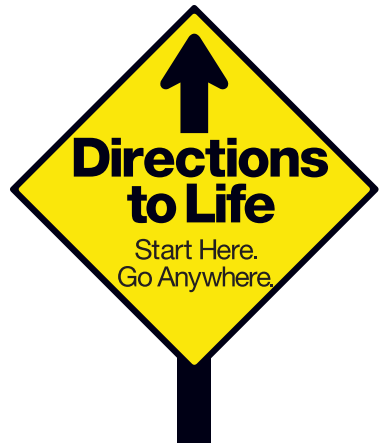
Why MSCC?
